## ...2009 Patronal Festival

The Feast of St James the Great falls on Saturday 25th July. We will begin with a Eucharist at 10am in the church and this will be followed immediately by GIFT DAY when you will find the Rector and Churchwardens sitting under the Lychgate to receive any gifts or donations for the upkeep of our magnificent Church. Please use the Gift Day envelope provided with this Newsletter, or fill in a Gift Aid donation envelope and we will get an extra 28% on the value of your donation from the taxman with no trouble to yourself!



Then on Sunday 26th of July the new Bishop of Truro, Bishop Timothy Thornton will be visiting Kilkhampton and taking a major role in our Patronal Festival Service to which I invite the entire village. It would be good to have people and representatives from our organisations and industries, farms and shops to meet our Bishop and hear what he has to say as he joins us to celebrate St James's Day. I came across an old poem written by Joseph Westaway from Buses Mill in 1887. I quote a small part of it:

**"There's lots of fun and smalls the fee, One shilling only, including tea,  
Enjoy yourself and wend your way, to church on glad St James's Day.  
A new Westminster Bishop is going to preach, Pay heed to the lessons that he will teach.  
Let all unite with him to pray, And celebrate St James's Day."**

**Who is St James the Great?** James and his brother John were sons of Zebedee and fishermen from Galilee - the 'sons of thunder', as the gospel writers describe their impetuous characters and fiery tempers.

James stands out on three accounts: he was one of the three disciples who witnessed the Transfiguration of Christ. Jesus took him, along with Peter and John, to 'watch' with him in the garden of Gethsemane. Finally, he went on to be the first apostle to die for the Christian faith, when in AD 44 King Herod Agrippa put him to the sword in Jerusalem at Passover time. The type of sword used is featured on our noticeboard.

In the centuries following his death, James became associated with the evangelising of Spain, and as a powerful defender of Christianity against the Moors. The heyday of the cult of Santiago de Compostela was from the 12th to the 15th century, and the pilgrimage to Compostela became one of the most important of medieval Christendom. This, in time, transformed the iconography of James, and his emblems became the pilgrim's hat and the scallop-shell of Compostela. Over 400 English churches have been dedicated to James.

So lets all unite and make this Patronal Festival Sunday one to remember for the entire village and for Bishop Tim...and for myself and Judith as, in September, we disappear over the hill at Crimp into retirement and oblivion!

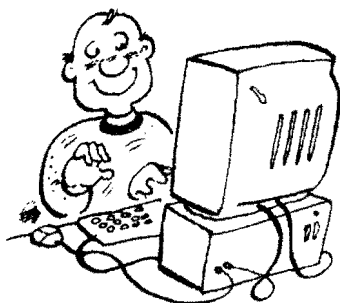

**Stressed? When?**

At what point in the week do you feel most stressed? Think about it. Could it be Tuesday mornings, about 11.45am?

That is when, according to a survey by a health supplement firm, nearly half of all workers feel under pressure: late morning on the second working day of the week. It seems that most of us coast through Monday trying to get our brains just into gear. By Tuesday morning we are finally 'revved up' - and by Tuesday lunchtime - all stressed out again.

**Is it a sheep? Or a bluebell? Or don't you know?**

The countryside is boring. Or, at least that is the opinion of more than a half of the population of the UK. In fact, one in three of us say that we have never even considered visiting a rural area.

These are the findings of a recent survey, conducted by OnePoll on behalf of Travel Lodge. It also made the somewhat startling discovery that apparently one in 10 adults cannot identify a sheep. 44 per cent of us cannot identify an oak tree, and a staggering 83 percent of us don't know a bluebell when we see one.

The professor of tourism at the University of Surrey, John Tribe, says: "It is alarming news... but maybe this is because in the last decade Britons have preferred to holiday abroad."

So - where will you spend your holiday this year? Is the British countryside too boring for words? Do sheep really look a lot like cows, in any case? What do you think? Tell us what's so good about a visit to the British countryside - or why we should avoid it all costs! If you have any memories of holidays there, do let us know.... either way.

**Funeral music goes pop!**

If you attend a funeral nowadays, you are much more likely to hear chart hits, anthems from the talent show X Factor, or even TV theme tunes rather than the traditional hymns such as Abide with Me or Amazing Grace.

A survey of 30,000 funerals last year found that hymns were most popular at only 35% of services, down from 41% in 2005. 58% of all requests were for contemporary songs, with only seven per cent of requests being made for classical music.

'My Way' by Frank Sinatra is overall most favourite. Next comes 'Wind Beneath My Wings' by Bette Midler, and 'Time to Say Good-bye' by Andrea Bocelli and Sarah Brightman. Other, more unusual requests have included Radio 4's 'Shipping Forecast', and the themes from 'Only Fools and Horses', 'Top Gear' and Channel 4 'Racing'.

The survey was carried out by Co-operative Funeralcare.

### **Parish Council Meeting**

The Parish Council Meeting was held on Monday 1st June with Heather Jordan in the chair. She was accompanied by 8 members.

The first item on the agenda was a short talk from 2 Fire-fighters from Bude Fire Station. They spoke about recent changes within the Cornwall Fire Service, their training, call out times and the maintenance of fire hydrants. They can also provide a free fire prevention service to all residents and certain vulnerable residents can benefit from free fire alarms. At the conclusion of their talk they took questions and were then thanked by the chairman for their attendance. The meeting then discussed 2 recent complaints by residents about **dog fouling**, especially in the **North Close and Barn Lane** areas. If you are a dog owner it is repeated that you have a responsibility to clean up after your dog. If you fail to do so and you are identified, you will leave yourself open to a Fixed Penalty Notice. The Parish Council, on behalf of all residents, ask all dog owners to comply with their obligations.

The meeting discussed our highways and damage was reported to the footway in The Square. As a result of a pedestrian being injured in The Square it was decided by a narrow vote to request the Highway Authority to consider a ' Safety Railing ' similar to the one that is outside the Lamb Park entrance. It was also noted that the road at Buses Mill will be closed for the entire month of August, and that a diversion route will be signed by the Highway Authority. Other matters discussed were the Parish Plan Review, The Grenville Rooms, Lamb Park buildings, damage to the new bus shelter, and the Cornwall Council Elections.

There were sadly very few volunteers to assist with a recent ' Parish Clean up ' and it was agreed to attempt another one. Many of you will have noticed the green notices stating that Kilkhampton has again been entered in the ' **Best Kept Village** ' Competition. Whilst the parish now employs a 'litter picker', it is hoped that ALL residents will have pride in their village and not drop sweet papers or other litter in the street as we can expect to be inspected twice during the months of June and July.

Correspondence discussed included a Management Plan for the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and a letter from another Cornish Parish Council about Quality Councils.

A Planning Application for; Mr J Rasher of V5, Spanish Villas, Penstowe Holiday Park was discussed and Planning Approvals were received for; Messrs Spence at Bryder Farn, Stibb, John Pearson of Moonins Barn, Stibb, and Kenyon Dean of No 1, Spanish Villas, Penstowe Holiday Park.

A letter of complaint had been sent to CC Planning Department regarding certain inconsistencies that are perceived by this Parish Council in the Planning Decisions of Cornwall Council. A letter from that department in response was read to the meeting.
